Maritime Short Range Operator's Certificate (MSROC)

A requirement for anyone wishing to operate a VHF radio in Europe and a prerequisite for the RYA International Certificate of Competence (ICC).



Aim: To learn Global Maritime Distress and Safety System (GMDSS) and enable one to receive distress, urgency and safety alerts and routine messages via a VHF Digital Selective calling (DSC) equipped maritime radio transceiver.

Duration: 6 Hours (followed by a one hour practical examination)

Qualification: Maritime Short Range Operator's Certificate (MSROC)

Maritime Short Range Operator's Certificate Home Study

The MSROC Course is currently only available in Home Study format, making it available nationwide from Coastguard Boating Education.

The Maritime Short-Range Operators Certificate is only available within New Zealand.
