Club Safety Boat Operator - Yachting

A theoretical and practical on-water opportunity to demonstrate boat-handling skills for yachting club coaches and safety boat operators. Recommended by Yachting New Zealand.



Aim: To demonstrate safety knowledge and proficiency in coach and safety boat operation, enabling better safety cover for sailors involved in yacht club activities.

Duration: 8 Hours.

Qualification: Club Safety Boat Operator Certificate (Endorsed by Yachting NZ).

Prerequisites: Maritime VHF Operator's Certificate and First Aid recommended. RYA Powerboat Level Two recommended for craft powered by 25HP and above.

- Preparation, Boat Checks & Safety Equipment
- New Zealand Law
- Launching & Retrieving
- Boat Handling
- Mark Laying
- Communication
- Righting Inverted & Partially Inverted Craft
- Casualty Rescue
- Towing
- End of Day Procedures

These courses are provided by experienced powerboat instructors - available throughout the country. Courses are ideally run at the yacht club, for its members, as vessels, hazards and processes will be club-specific. The Club Safety Officer should be in attendance to assist with training on club specific procedures and equipment.
