Club Safety Boat Operator - Yacht Club Version

Recommended by Yachting New Zealand. A practical on-water training course for yacht club coaches and safety boat operators.



Aim: To gain safety knowledge and proficiency in safety boat operation, enabling better safety cover for sailors involved in yacht club activities.

Duration: 8 Hours.

Qualification: Club Safety Boat Operator Qualification (Endorsed by Yachting NZ).

Prerequisites: Marine VHF Radio Operators and First Aid recommended. Powerboat Level Two recommended for craft powered by 25HP and above.

- Preparation, Boat Checks & Safety Equipment
- New Zealand Law
- Launching & Retrieving
- Boat Handling
- Mark Laying
- Communication
- Righting Inverted & Partially Inverted Craft
- Casualty Rescue
- Towing
- End of Day Procedures
