Coastal Medic



An intermediate course for coastal boating within 24 hours of assistance.

Aim: To detail the management of trauma up to 24 hours with little outside assistance and medical equipment.

Duration: 16 Hours.

Qualification: Coastal Medic Certificate (Recognised by Maritime New Zealand for commercial qualifications, and as a Workplace First Aid).

Unit Standard: 6400, 6401, 6402. 5 credits, level 1, 2 and 3.

Prerequisites: None.

Valid: Two years from date of issue.

Modules:

- Airway, Breathing and Circulation
- Injury Identification
- Stabilisation/Treatment
- Evacuation
- Documentation

Meets requirements for Work Place First Aid and Level 2 First Aid.

This course is a prerequisite for the Offshore Medic course.
