

Maritime Short Range Operator's Certificate (MSROC)

A requirement for anyone wishing to operate a Maritime VHF Radio in Europe, and a prerequisite for the RYA Yachtmaster Certificates of Competence.



Aim: To learn the Global Maritime Distress and Safety System (GMDSS) and enable one to receive Distress, Urgency, and Safety alerts and routine messages via a VHF Digital Selective Calling (DSC) equipped maritime radio transceiver.

Duration: 8 Hours

Qualification: Maritime Short Range Operator's Certificate

The MSROC Course is currently only available in Home Study with resources posted to you, making it available nationwide from Coastguard Boating Education. You have 15 weeks to complete the course. Includes: Handbook, Exercise book, Study guide and other boating safety information.
