A minimum requirement for anyone wishing to operate a Maritime VHF radio.
A legal requirement for all users of Maritime VHF Radio except in an Emergency

Aim: To learn correct maritime VHF radio operation

Duration: 6 Hours

Why it is important to use a Marine VHF Radio:

- To communicate distress immediately.
- Continuous contact with Search & Rescue nationwide.
- To hear other boaties in distress.
- To get regular weather updates.
- A cell phone lets you talk to one person, a VHF lets you talk to many people.
- It could save your life in an emergency.

Modules:

1. Routine Operation

- Common Features & Functions
- Pro-words & Phonetic Alphabet
- Call signs & Channel allocation

2. Safety

- Trip Reports
- Weather Information
- Sécurité

3. Distress & Urgency

- "Mayday" & "Pan" calls
- EPIRB and Search and Rescue Information
