

Offshore Medic



An advanced course for those heading offshore. A requirement for a Category 1 Certificate.

Aim: To detail the management of trauma on-board up to 5 days without medical assistance.

Duration: 8 Hours.

Qualification: Offshore Medic Certificate

Prerequisites: Current Coastal Medic Certificate or other Level 2 First Aid Certificate.

Valid: Two years from date of issue.

Modules:

1. Trauma Management

- Advanced Airway Management
- Oxygen Administration
- Advanced Chest Injury Management
- Fluid Resuscitation

2. Medical Management

- Medical Assessment
- Symptomatic Treatment
- Administration of Medicines
- Advanced Wound Closure

Category 1 certificates: YNZ Safety Regulations state: Two Crew members should have a current first aid certificate and a minimum of one crew member (suggested 2 crew members) should have an advanced first aid certificate or special training, covering the safe use of medications and treatments required for offshore sailing.
